Congratulations! The Behavior Analyst Certification Board®, Inc. (BACB®) has contingently approved via an Alternate Pathway the course sequence that you submitted from the International Training Center for Applied Behavior Analysis (hereafter referred to as the ITC) as meeting the 180-hour coursework requirement for taking the Board Certified Assistant Behavior Analyst® (BCaBA®) examination that will go into effect in 2015. The following modification to our course-sequence requirements will be permitted under an Alternative Pathway: use of non-university behavior-analytic coursework. As this was the only modification, note that all other course-sequence requirements (e.g., instructor qualifications) must be met.

The BCaBA course sequence approval number for the ITC is 4024. Your course sequence is valid until December 31, 2016, at which time an annual renewal will be required for the course sequence. Your Alternative Pathway is valid until December 31, 2017, by which time the coursework should be housed within a university program. This approval is subject to your program's ongoing compliance with the attached Alternate Pathway Terms and Conditions. I will need a signed copy of the attached Terms and Conditions on file before the approval is official. A scanned or faxed copy would be fine.

Once I receive the signed Terms and Conditions, your program will be permitted to state to candidates the following:

"The Behavior Analyst Certification Board,® Inc. has approved the following course sequence as meeting the coursework requirements for eligibility to take the Board Certified Assistant Behavior Analyst® Examination. Applicants will have to meet additional requirements to qualify."



We believe that this approval process is an important step in creating an educational and career path for professional behavior analysts in Nigeria that will be beneficial to all. Thank you for your interest and commitment to this important process.
